Organization History

The National Muslim Business Council began in 1990 and was originally named the North Carolina Muslim Business Council. It started with a group of businesspersons coming together to establish meetings and to help others to learn about business. These people came from around North Carolina and outside of North Carolina. The Council was meant to be an information base to help people start up a small business and work with individuals that were already in business. We established monthly networking meetings once a month in Fayetteville, NC. In late 2006, David Hasan reorganized a group of community leaders to re-establish the North Carolina Muslim Business Council. As a result, some of the members started new businesses. In 2006, a CPC Product & Service Business Conference was suggested, and Mr. Hasan brought the idea back to the North Carolina Muslim Business Council. The Council was very instrumental in helping to establish 35-40 CPC distributorships around the country.

Mr. Hasan led NMBC into numerous cities across USA; and recently opened NMBC Africa office in Dakar, Senegal, West Africa. Mr. Hasan was in business for over 50 years and, as an entrepreneur, had several businesses and received many accolades, honors and awards for outstanding business achievements within the business world. He was a member of the Small Business Council of President Barack Obama. He was instrumental in the opening of the Muhammad Ali Center in Louisville, Kentucky. He was appointed by the Governor of North Carolina to the Business Round Table and served on many boards: Board of Directors of the Chamber of Commerce; Advisory Board for Early Childhood Education for Fayetteville Technical Community College; Vice Chair of the Cumberland County Joint Planning Board in Fayetteville, North Carolina.


In 1987, Mr. Hasan led the community in building the first mosque from the ground up in North Carolina. Masjid Omar Ibn Sayyid, the Islamic Mosque named after a Muslim Scholar from Africa who escaped from slavery in South Carolina but later caught and imprisoned in Fayetteville, an historical monument, helped establish the W. D. Mohammed Islamic Center in Greensboro, NC and on this same campus the current Board of Directors named a building in his honor: Imam David K. Hasan Business and Culture Center in 2022. NMBC joint ventured with the African Diaspora's group headed by 1st appointed Ambassador from USA in Sierre Leone H.E. Waleed Shamsid Deen, Special Envoy Investment and Trade & others. He accommodated over 47 delegates in joining thousands of African businessmen and women to attend the first led NMBC Conference on the continent of West Africa. This conference was therefore fulfilling a promise made seven years earlier by the Ambassador Permanent Representative Du Senegal His Excellency Fode Seck and Mr. Hasan toured with Bachirou Seck, NMBC Africa's new manager and met the highest Muslim leaders in Senegal including Sheikh Mouhamadou Mountkha MBACKE, his wife Sokhna baly MBACKE(Touba), Cheikh Ahmed Tidiane SY Al Amine and his brother Cheikh Moustapha SY, on behalf of the Khalife Cheikh Mohamadou Mansour SY (Tivaoune), and Cheikh Mouhamadou Lamine LAYE, spokesman and personal representative of Cheikh Mouhamadou Moctar LAYE, Khalife General of the Layene Community. At the institutional level, he met and discussed with the Minister of Tourism and Leisure, and the Department of Trade and Commerce, business opportunities for Muslim African Americans wanting to invest in Africa.

Today, the Council consists of NMBC International Business Executive Director, Sis.

Barbara BaSeemah Calhoun-Hasan and a Steering Committee with a focus toward continuing the legacy and the concept from an Islamic and non-Islamic Perspective how on we can work together for the Advancement of the Communities. The Council has committed to hosting the business conference on an Annual Basis.


EDUCATION LEVEL




GENDER
